ORDER

In this application, Pacific Greyhound Lines seeks authority to make a minor change in the route of its line through the City of Glendale in order to serve a new passenger station located at the intersection of Brand Boulevard and Lomita Avenue.

No changes in fares or schedules are involved and the request appears to be in the public interest, and will be granted. No public hearing is necessary.

THEFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the description of the route contained in Decision No. 31869, dated March 27, 1939, on Application No. 22635, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Between the intersection of San Fernando Road and Colorado Boulevard and the intersection of San Fernando Road and Brand Boulevard via Colorado Boulevard, to Brand Boulevard to Lomita Avenue to the Company's station at the intersection of Brand Boulevard and Lomita Avenue; thence from the Company's station via Brand Boulevard to its intersection with San Fernando Road; or direct between said first two mentioned points via San Fernando Road.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
