BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing (a) the abandonment of its Class C Non-Agency Station at Kemp, County of Los Angeles, State) Application of California; (b) the abandonment and re-) No. 25417 moval of a side track approximately 2,028 feet in length; and (c) the cancellation of all fraight rate tariffs to and from said station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Kemp during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintonance.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Kemp, County of Los Angeles; to remove a side track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancol all tariffs and time schedulos applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be offective immediately.
