O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 35597, rendered July 21, 1942, in Application No. 25132, the Commission granted a certificate to D. Moyers authorizing the establishment of a passenger stage service between Dos Palos and Eagle Field and intermediate points.

In the application herein considered, Moyers requests authority to suspend that service until passenger traffic conditions warrant its re-establishment.

In justification of the authority sought applicant alleges

- (a) That the Coast Aviation Company, operators of Eagle Field, have advised applicant that upon the completion of the housing project at Eagle Field (February 1, 1943) his common carrier service between Dos Palos and Eagle Field will no longer be necessary.
- (b) That the Coast Aviation Company has purchased its own bus which it will use to transport its personnel to and from Eagle Field.

After due consideration it appears that applicant's request is reasonable and should be granted for a specific time with the understanding that the Commission will entertain a further request from the applicant in the matter of further extension based upon the conditions then obtaining. The order will so provide. This is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary.

O R D E R

It being hereby found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that D. Moyers is hereby authorized to suspend passenger stage service between Dos Palos and Eagle Field and intermediate points as heretofore authorized by Decision No. 35597, dated July 21, 1942, until February 1, 1944.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that D. Moyers shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, file appropriate supplements to his tariffs and time schedules reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
