FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding Harry C. Hicks originally sought a certificate authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service between Riverside, Camp Haan, Perris, Elsinore and Hemet. A public hearing thereon was had during which applicant requested that that portion of the application seeking a certificate between Riverside and Camp Haan be removed from the calendar and be reset for further hearing upon request therefor by said applicant. A certificate was granted to applicant by the Commission's Decision No. 34644, rendered October 7, 1941, authorizing service between Camp Haan and points southerly thereof, viz., Perris, Elsinore and Hemet.

On January 14, 1943 the Commission was informed by applicant, through counsel, that it no longer desires to proceed with that portion of the application dealing with its request for a certificate between Riverside and Camp Haan and requests a dismissal thereof.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 24372 is dismissed in all respects except as heretofore granted by the Commission's Decision No. 34644, rendered October 7, 1941.
