BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing (a) the abandonment of its Class C Station at McPherson, County of Los Angeles, State of California; (b) the abandonment of a team spur track 1,065 feet in length, and the freight platform; and (c) the cancellation of all freight rate tariffs to and from said station.

O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of McPherson for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of McPherson, County of Orange (erroneously called County of Los Angeles in application); to remove a team track and freight platform at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
