ORDER

Investigation discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's station of Lick during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance as a Class C station and that the public will not be inconvenienced if this station is reclassified as a Class E station where freight is not received or delivered.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of Lick, County of Santa Clara, from Class "C" to Class "E"; to remove a spur track, and discontinue the receipt and delivery of freight at said station; to modify its station records, tariffs and time schedules accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
