In the Matter of the Application of NORTHWESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY for an order authorizing (a) the abandonment of its Class B Freight Station at Deer Lodge, County of Mendocino, State of California; (b) the abandonment and removal of a spur track 247 feet in length; and (c) the cancellation of all freight rate tariffs to and from said station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Deer Lodge for more than two years and that; continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Gause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Deer Lodge, County of Mendocino; to remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
