BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Investigation discloses that the stock corrals and the track serving them at applicant's station of Templeton have not been used for over a year and that the amount of use made of these corrals during recent years no longer warrants their continued maintenance. Other livestock handling facilities are available at Paso Robles, six miles to the north, and at Santa Margarita 14 miles south. The abandonment of the Templeton facilities will make available urgently needed materials for use at other points.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its stock corrals at Templeton, County of San Luis Obispo, and to remove the spur track serving said corrals.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
