FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The order of Decision No. 36136 became effective January 26, 1943. Subsequent thereto, applicant was advised by the United States Post Office Department that consideration is being given to a plan of changing the mail route and schedules from that originally proposed in the application. Applicant is of the opinion that a decision on the future routes, schedules and termini of his existing mail contract will not be finally determined until ninety (90) days from date and that until such determination he will not be able to ascertain whether the operation authorized in the certificate will be economically possible.

For these reasons the request of applicant for an extension of ninety (90) days from the date hereof within which to file written acceptance of the certificate granted in Decision No. 36136, and to file tariffs and time schedules with the Commission, is hereby granted. If, in the meantime, it should appear that any changes are made effective by the Post Office Department by which termini or schedules are altered, the matter

may be re-opened for further consideration upon the filing of an appropriate supplemental application.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
