BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate its main line track and passing track and to construct a drill track at grade across Shearer Avenue in Dunsmuir, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-321.7. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 11%. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O.No. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
