BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a spur track at grade over and across Ocean Avenue in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Ocean Avenue in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3A-25.87^{26-C}~~87-C~~. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). 1500

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
