ORDER

The verified application of Pacific Electric Railway Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at several of applicant's stations for more than five years, and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations as follows;

to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment of the stations, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
