BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to construct a spur track at grade across the intersection of 20th and Kirkham Streets in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application.

This order is made upon the condition that said streets are not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said streets to public use across said track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
