OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Nevada Irrigation District have entered into, as of the 22nd day of December, 1942, an operating agreement modifying certain former similar contracts heretofore approved by this Commission in Decisions No. 13792, No. 21347 and No. 26098. The present agreement provides for joint control and use of waters of the said District and Company for their mutual advantage in the generation of electric energy and the transmission and distribution of water for irrigation, domestic and other purposes by the parties to said agreement, subject to approval of this Commission.

In view of the fact that both the District and the Company have joined in this application and it appearing that a public hearing therein is unnecessary and that the request should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Nevada Irrigation District, a California Irrigation District, substantially in the words and figures as set

forth in the copy of said proposed agreement attached to the application herein and marked "Exhibit I," which said Exhibit is hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall file with this Commission four true copies of this said agreement as finally executed, within thirty (30) days of consummation thereof.
