BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Tidewater Southern Railway Company and Modesto and Empire Traction Company are authorized to relocate existing spur and side tracks at grade across "D" Street and an alley in Block 51 in Modesto, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application and shown on the print attached thereto to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 75-30.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superclevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with readway, and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or

safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
