BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Atchison, Topcka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across portions of Minnesota Street in San Francisco at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2 SG-Q.19. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superclovation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
