O R D E R

The verified application of Howard Terminal indicates that the right of way proposed to be granted to Pacific Gas & Electric Company upon which it may erect and maintain a single line of poles and wires for the transmission of electricity will not in any way injure or affect the operations of applicant; therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be and it is hereby granted to Howard Terminal to grant to Pacific Gas and Electric Company a right of way for a pole line, as set forth in the application.

Within thirty days thereafter, applicant shall notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the transfer.

The authority herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
