ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Waldorf for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a Class "C" non-agency station where freight in carload lots or quantities not exceeding 5,000 pounds is delivered and received is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of Waldorf, County of Santa Barbara from Class "C" to Class "E," i.e., a station where no freight is handled; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
