BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The County of Riverside is authorized to construct Kuster Road at grade across the Corona Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6W-12.73. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than 12 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
