ORDER

Southern Pacific Company has made application to abandon its Class "C" non-agency station of Pabrico, Alameda County. Said station is located within the Niles yard limits and the only business handled is carload freight which will be handled on existing industry tracks as at present and be billed to and from Niles. During the 12-month period ending November 30, 1942, 234 carloads were so handled. The industries affected have been notified of the application and no protest has been filed. Freight rates applying at Pabrico are the same as at Niles, except on tile to Oakland, Richmond, and Schellville, of which there has been no movement during the last two years.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Pabrico, County of Alameda; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedulos applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
