ORDER REVOKING PRIOR ORDER

Key System, Defendant herein, has requested, in writing,
that the Order in Decision No. 34999, dated February 3, 1942, be
rescinded.

By Sixth Interim Order in Decision No. 34999, the request
of the City of Berkeley for extension of Shattuck Avenue Line "F"
from Northbrae Station northerly to The Alameda was denied, and
further, Key System was ordered to alter the track layout at the
eastern end of the Shattuck Avenue rail line to provide single track
facilities in the center of Sutter Street, in the vicinity of North-
brae Station.

Subsequently, by Order in Decision No. 35900, dated October
27, 1942, Key System was ordered to extend its rail service from
Northbrae Station through the Northbrae tunnel to a terminus at The
Alameda. This extension has been placed into effect.

It appears that the Order in Decision No. 34999 has no
further force and effect, and should be rescinded, therefore

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision
No. 34999 in Case No. 4478 be and it is hereby revoked and of no
further force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
