SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

M. L. O'Harra, applicant in the above-entitled proceeding, was granted a passenger stage certificate by Decision No. 34184, authorizing the operation of service between Barstow and Bicycle Lake.

On March 22 the Commission received from M. L. O'Harra a letter stating that he had discontinued the operation authorized by Decision No. 34814 and had disposed of all of his equipment. He requests the Commission to revoke the operative right created by that decision. Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right heretofore created by Decision No. 34184, rendered May 13, 1941, in the above-entitled proceeding, is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time schedules in effect and on file with the Commission in the name of M. L. O'Harra are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
