In the Matter of the Application of CENTRAL CALIFORNIA TRACTION COMPANY for authority to sell to the Standard Oil Company of California, a corporation, certain real property, in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, hereinafter more particularly described.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Central California Traction Company has applied for authority to sell certain parcels of operative property located in the vicinity of X and Commercial Streets in Sacramento, to Standard Oil Company for \$9,000. A public hearing is not necessary and the application should be granted, subject to certain conditions.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Central California Traction Company is authorized to sell to Standard Oil Company for a consideration of \$9,000.00 those parcels of operative property described in the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the property sale herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the sale herein authorized.
- (3) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
