ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 10104, rendered February 17, 1922, Cecil E. Snyder acquired a highway common carrier operative right for the transportation of milk between Los Angeles and a point in Los Angeles County outside the city of Los Angeles. By Decision No. 15531, rendered October 15, 1925, the Commission granted to said Snyder an extension of that operative right to and including Lynwood.

Snyder has informed the Commission in writing that he has abandoned that operation and disposed of all of his equipment and requests that the operative rights therefor be revoked and annulled. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative right acquired by Snyder under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 10104, on Application No. 7567, and the highway common carrier operative right created by Decision No. 15531, on Application No. 11121, are hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules in effect and on file with the Commission in the name of Cecil E. Snyder are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
