BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct six yard tracks at grade across Maine Street and Florida Street and relocate an existing track at grade across Maine Street in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the locations described in the application. Said streets are not at present improved or traveled, and this order shall not be considered as authority to open these streets across said tracks. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
