SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, in its letter of March 31, 1943, alleged that the Government does not consider that the human flagmen, provided by Decision No. 36189, dated February 24, 1943, in this proceeding, is sufficient protection at this crossing. The Army requests that this protection be replaced by flashing light signals and is agreeable to bearing the installation costs.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to install two Standard No. 8 flashing light crossing signals at Crossing No. B-617.4-C, in lieu of the human flagman protection now afforded at this location.

In all other respects, Decision No. 36189 shall remain in full force and effect.
