Good Cause Appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of Decision No. 20931 in this application is modified to read as follows:

- (3) No train, engine, motor, or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be under full control. Said crossing shall be further protected by the installation of floodlights and warning bells installed substantially in accordance with drawings filed with the Commission by the Ventura County Railway Company under date of April 15, 1943. Pending the installation of such protection, applicant shall continue to protect traffic on the highway by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of Ventura County Railway Company acting as flagman.

In all other respects Decision No. 20931 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
