ORDER

Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Willow Street in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application. Willow Street is not open to travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across said spur. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
