## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a passing track at grade across Damask Avenue and Hyde Park Boulevard, in the City of Inglewood, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 2W-10.1 and 2W-10.5, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction at each location shall be equal or superior to Std. No. 2 of G.O. No.72, without superelevation, and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding 4%. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authority may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
