ORDER

Investigation discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Warm Springs during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-sgency station of Warm Springs, County of Alameda; to remove a side track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancell all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Cormission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
