O P I N I O N

H. G. Reynolds requests authority to acquire a certificate issued to William Callahan in 1941 (Decision No. 34662, Application No. 24494), and authorizing passenger and express service between Lancaster and Polaris Flight Academy (War Eagle Field), some five miles from Lancaster.

According to the application, Callahan, whose present whereabouts is unknown, orally agreed to the transfer, but departed before the application was prepared. No value is placed upon the operative right. The equipment used was and is the property of Polaris Flight Academy, which is willing to furnish equipment and subsidize the operation, if necessary. Public hearing appears unnecessary.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that H. G. Reynolds is authorized to acquire the passenger stage operative right created by Decision No. 34662 in Application No. 24494, and to render service as a passenger stage corporation, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express on passenger carrying vehicles, between Lancaster and Polaris Flight Academy, provided that no shipment of express weighing in

excess of 100 pounds shall be transported.

The authority herein granted is subject to the provisions of section 52(b) of the Public Utilities Act, and further to the condition that H. G. Reynolds, his successors and assigns, shall never claim before this Commission or any court or other public body, a value for said operative right, or claim as the cost thereof an amount in excess of that paid for said right by those to whom said right was originally granted.

H. G. Reynolds shall comply with the rules of the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 80, and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time tables satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
