In the matter of the Application of the City of Chino for an order requiring the Southern Pacific Company to establish a grade crossing.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

**ORIGINAL**

The City of Chino is authorized to construct "F" Street at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Chino, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAB-520.3-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 20 feet and grades of approach not greater than 2 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O.No.75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
