In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of two (2) spur tracks across Orange Street, in the City of Alhambra, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one (1) spur track and relocate one (1) spur track at grade across Orange Street in Alhambra, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossing No. B-487.9-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
