ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 34452, dated July 29, 1941, the Commission authorized Pacific Motor Trucking Company to establish and operate a highway common carrier service within an area extending laterally ten miles on either side of U. S. Highway No. 101 between Santa Margarita and San Luis Obispo. This service was designed to serve the transportation needs incidental to construction work on a water development project within that area.

In its sixth supplemental application Pacific Motor Trucking Company asserts that that construction and water development project is now completed and there is no longer a public need for its transportation service and requests the Commission to revoke the operative right therefor as created by said Decision No. 34452.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Motor Trucking Company may abandon the highway common carrier operation authorized by Decision No. 34452 and the operative right therefor created by said Decision is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Motor Trucking Company shall, within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and

on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, cancel all tariffs and time tables showing rates, charges and service to and from the points affected by this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
