ZEFORE THE RAILROAD COMASSION OF THE STATE OE CATIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CARRIE HAPPE to sell and of V. P. ORTCMAL HUNI, $\mathrm{d} / \mathrm{b} / \mathrm{a}$ V. P. EINT TRANSPORTATION, to purchase the certificate of public, Application No. 25509 convenience and necessity and certain automotive ecuipment used in connection therewith.

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The appication herein requests authorization for the transfer of a highway common carrier operetive right between Vucaipa Valley territory and Los ingeles, together with 8 trucks, 8 trailers, and certain other equipment, from Carrie: Jappe to V. P. Funt. The certificate creating the operative right wes issued to $A . J$. Happe in 1923 (Decision No. 12422, Application No. 8989), and transfer thereof to Carrie Eappe was authorized in 1927 (Decision No. 17859, Application NO. 13450\%

The total consideration involved is $\$ 15,000$. The applicants assert that $\$ 13,500$ of this sum represents the value of the equipment. The romaincer apparently represents the value of the operative right although the appifcation is not clear in this respect: Such may be the understanding between the parties, but it should be clearly understood that the authorization hereinafter granted is not an approval of the purchase price in any respect, nor a finding of value for the purpose of rate firing, issuance of sccurities, accounting, or for any other purpose. No examination has been made by this Commission, nor by its authorized representatives, of the phrsical assets involved in this trensfer as to their existence, value or ownership.
V. P. Eunt is placod upon notice that "operative rights" as such do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an element of value in rate fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originaliy paid to the state as the consideration for
the grant of such rights. Aside from their pureiy permissive aspect, they extend to the holder a full or pertial monopoly of a class of business over a particular route. This monopoly feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the State which is not in any respect Iimited to the number of rights which may be given.

Pabilc hearing appears unnecessary and the requested transfer will be authorized

ORDER
Good cause appearing,
IT IS ORDERED as follows:
(1) That Carrie Eappe is authorized to transfer and V. P. Funt is authorized to ocquire that certain highray comon carrier operative right between Vucaipa Valley Territory and Los fngeles heretofore acquired by Carrie Happe pursuant to the authorization granted by Decision No. 17859, in Application No. 13450, together with the equipment specified in the bill of sale attached as Exhibit "A" to the present application.
(2) That the authority herein granted is subject to the provisions of section 52 (b) of the Fublic Utilities Act, and further to the condition that V. P. Eunt, his successors and assigns, shail never claim before this Commission or any court or other public body, a value for said operative rights, or claim as the cost thereof an amount in excess of that paid for said rights by those to whom said rights were originally granted.
(3) That applicants horein shail comply with the rules Of the Commission's General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by ililng, in tripifeate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schecules satisfactory to the

Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective slate hereof and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission.
