BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 36099, dated January 5, 1943, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized to construct a spur track across certain streets within the County of Orange. The railway advises that the facility is nearing completion, except for the automatic crossing protection ordered at Talbert Avenue (Crossing No. 6N-39.18-C), and alleges that the War Production Board has not released the necessary materials to provide for such installation.

The railway reaffirms its belief in the justification of automatic signals at this point and signifies its intention of continuing its efforts to secure the necessary material release. In order to expedite the use of the facility, however, the railway now seeks permission to substitute two Standard No. 1 crossing signs in lieu of the automatic signals provided in the original order.

Good Cause Appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to install two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at Crossing No. 6N-39.18-C, in lieu of two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), providing, however, that all rail movements be brought

to a positive stop immediately prior to entering Talbert Avenue. Upon the installation of the two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals, the safety stop, herein provided, shall be discontinued.

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
