BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant is a public utility warehouseman operating stor-
age facilities at Terminal Island in the City of Los Angeles. It was
authorized by Decision No. 35368 of May 12, 1942, in this proceeding,
to lease 60,628 square feet of its warehouse space to the California
Shipbuilding Corporation and/or the United States Maritime Commission;
to suspend public warehouse operation of the space covered by the
lease until May 12, 1943; and to establish and operate, during the
effectiveness of the lease, other warehouse space on Terminal Island
which would not exceed the leased space in footage. By supplemental
application, filed May 28, 1943, applicant seeks to extend the lease
to May 12, 1945, to continue the suspension of public utility ware-
house operation of the space involved for the period of this exten-
sion, and to establish and operate additional space during that period
under the same conditions as those previously authorized.

It is represented that the lessees require the facilities
involved for their activities in connection with the war effort, and
that the granting of the supplemental application will thus serve the
public interest.

Under the circumstances, it appears that this is a matter in
which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the
sought authority is justified. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Crescent Warehouse Company, Limited, be and it is hereby authorized to extend the lease authorized by Decision No. 35368 of May 12, 1942, in this proceeding, to May 12, 1945; to suspend public utility warehouse operation of the space covered by said lease until May 12, 1945; and to establish and operate during the effectiveness of said lease additional warehouse space on Terminal Island, City of Los Angeles, not exceeding 60,628 square feet.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Crescent Warehouse Company, Limited, shall, immediately upon exercising the authority herein granted to suspend operation of the space permitted to be leased, amend its tariffs on file with the Commission on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public to show that operations have been suspended as authorized herein; and that the authority to establish and operate additional space herein granted is subject to the condition that such space shall not be operated unless and until tariffs on file with the Commission are amended accordingly.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
