ORDER

The verified application of The Western Pacific Railroad. Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of Gocken and Strauch for more than a year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Western Pacific Railroad Companis authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Gocken, Alamed County, and Strauch, Sacramento County; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
