ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct two (2) additional tracks and relocate three (3) existing tracks at grade across Rialto Avenue in the City of San Bernardino, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossing No. 2B-0.3.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and grades of approach not exceeding 2%. Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs and one (1) Standard No. 3 wigwas (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
