OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Madison Warehouse Company seeks authority to lease to Clifford W. Garrison, designated warehouse property and equipment used in the public utility warehouse business conducted at Esparto and Madison, Yolo County, as "Madison Warehouses." A copy of the lease which applicants propose to execute is on file in this proceeding as Exhibit "D". Applicants represent that the company desires to withdraw from the warehouse business and that Garrison will use the leased property to provide the public with service comparable to that now rendered by the company. No change in the tariff rates is proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.
Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Madison Warehouse Company be and it is hereby authorized to lease to Clifford W. Garrison the property used in the operation of public utility warehouses situated at Esparto and Madison and described in this application as the "Madison Warehouses," in accordance with the terms of the proposed lease set forth in Exhibit "D" of the application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER CRDERED that the authority herein granted is subject to the condition that Madison Warehouse Company and Clifford W. Garrison shall comply with the requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 61 by filing, in duplicate, and concurrently making effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hercof.
