O R D E R

In the above numbered application Asbury Rapid Transit System seeks authority to reroute a portion of its Pasadena-Eagle Rock-Glendale-Hollywood motor coach line, in order to eliminate operation through the bus terminal located at 1629 Cahuenga Avenue, Hollywood. Applicant alleges that a termination of its joint usage of this facility with Pacific Greyhound Lines is being negotiated by agreement whereby the present arrangements will remain in effect only until July 31, 1943.

The Board of Public Utilities and Transportation of the City of Los Angeles is on record as approving the application for rerouting.

In this proceeding no change of tariffs or time schedules is involved.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Asbury Rapid Transit System is hereby authorized to reroute all motor coach service on its Pasadena-Eagle Rock-Glendale-Hollywood motor coach line, between the intersection of Cahuenga Avenue and Hollywood Boulevard and the

intersection of Wilcox Avenue and Hollywood Boulevard, so that said line will operate eastbound as well as westbound along Hollywood Boulevard between the above named points, thus eliminating any operation through the present bus terminal on Cahuenga Avenue.

This authorization is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall give the public at least five (5) days' notice of the rerouting authorized herein, by posting notices in all coaches operating on the line involved and at all stations affected.
- (2) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days after the expiration of the five-day period herein referred to, advise the Commission, in writing, of the rerouting herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
