ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 35760, rendered September 15, 1942, in the above entitled matter, a certificate of public convenience and necessity was granted to R. G. Jones and C. C. Fraseur authorizing the transportation of passengers between Ontario, Rialto, Fontana and the Kaiser Steel Mill near Fontana, subject to certain restrictions.

On June 2, 1943, the Commission was informed by R. G. Jones that this operation was discontinued and abandoned during December 1942. It is stated that this abandonment occurred due to gas rationing and a lack of sufficient traffic to warrant continuance of the service. The equipment used in this operation, so it is asserted, has been reclaimed by the owner.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right heretofore created by Decision No. 35760 is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name

of R. G. Jones and C. C. Fraseur and in effect are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
