O P I N I O N

In this proceeding applicant seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport freight and express between Keddie and Greenville and intermediate points in Plumas County. A public hearing was held in this matter at Greenville, July 30, 1943, before Examiner Hunter.

At the hearing applicant stated that, subsequent to the time he filed this application, he had made further investigation relative to the matter under consideration and reached the conclusion that he did not desire to conduct the common carrier service applied for and, therefore, requested that the application be dismissed.

The Mt. Lassen Motor Transit, Inc., among other operations, conducts common carrier service for the transportation of freight and express between Keddie and Greenville for which applicant herein seeks a certificate. Representatives from Mt. Lassen Motor Transit

stated that they were now providing all the service in this field that could be reasonably justified from the standpoint of public necessity, and stood ready and willing to meet any reasonable public demands that developed in the future.

In the light of the above, this application will be dismissed and the following order will so provide.

O R D E R

Public hearing having been held in the above-entitled matter and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that this application be dismissed without prejudice.
