FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On April 14, 1942 this Commission issued its Decision No. 35248 authorizing Applicant, San Diego Gas and Electric Company, to deliver electric energy at the international border near Tia Juana to M. P. Barbachano and Border Telephone & Light Company, in accordance with rates, conditions and terms of an agreement which has been attached to and made a part of the original application.

In this first supplemental application authority is requested to amend the original agreement by revising same to permit the delivery of energy at a load not exceeding 2,000 kilowatts, rather than at a maximum load of 1,000 kilowatts. An agreement, attached to the supplemental application as Exhibit "A," to provide for such amendment, was executed by Applicant and M. P. Barbachano and Border Telephone & Light Company on July 9, 1943.

It is provided in the amendment that except as modified the original agreement shall otherwise remain unchanged; that such agreement shall not become effective until it has been authorized by this Commission; and furthermore, that the agreement shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Railroad Commission of the State of California as said Commission may from time to time direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

The Commission, having considered the request of Applicant and it being of the opinion that the application should be granted, that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary and sufficient cause appearing, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to enter into that certain proposed agreement with M. P. Barbachano and Border Telephone and Light Company, substantially in form and content as attached to the First Supplemental Application No. 24750 and marked Exhibit "A," and to supply electric service to said M. P. Barbachano and Border Telephone & Light Company under the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement.

The authority herein granted shall become effective as of the date hereof.
