BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and El Dorado Irrigation District, a public corporation, have made joint application to the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a written agreement, entered into in the form hereunto attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A," providing among other things, for an increase in the existing limitations of forty (40) cubic feet of water per second from noontime of May 15 to noontime of October 15, and seven (7) cubic feet therefor per second from noontime of October 15 to noontime of May 15, to provide for extra and additional water for the use of Victory Gardens during a 1943 irrigation season at the rate of flow not exceeding two hundred (200) miner's inches of water, ⁽¹⁾ and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted, now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Pacific Gas and Electric Company and El Dorado Irrigation District be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an

⁽¹⁾ For the purpose of this agreement, a miner's inch shall be one-fortieth (1/40th) of a cubic foot of water per second.

agreement, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and which is hereby made part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, shall file with this Commission within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two (2) certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
