O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a passing track at grade across Cota and Railroad Streets in Corona, Riverside County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. 2B-24.5 and 2B-25.6, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding 6 per cent. No additional protection is required.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
