BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct, operate and maintain spur or side track upon and across 223rd Street, in the County of Los Angeles, on its San Pedro Main Line

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct one side track at grade across 223rd Street at Bangie Station, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6M-15.98. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
