SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER FURTHER SUSPENDING RATES

On April 6, 1943, the Commission ordered that an investigation on its own motion be instituted to determine whether or not Walton N. Moore Corporation in rendering certain heat service in San Francisco is a public utility and further ordered that the operation of a certain tariff schedule applicable to heating service consisting of Original C.R.C. Sheets Nos. 1H, 2H and 3H which was filed by said corporation on March 16, 1943, be suspended for a period of 120 days from April 6, 1943. On July 27, 1943 the period of suspension was by supplemental order extended for a further period of sixty days. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the period of suspension so ordered be extended for a further period of sixty days.
