In the Matter of the Application of MELVIN WILLIAMS for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate bus transportation service as a common carrier between Hobsonway and Commercial Street in the City of Blythe, and a point approximately seven miles northwest therefrom, all in County of Riverside, State of California.)

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 35673, dated August 11, 1942, in the above entitled proceeding, Melvin Williams was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined by section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, between Blythe and Morton Air Academy, located approximately seven miles northwest of Blythe.

Said decision provided that applicant should file written acceptance of the certificate therein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days, and also file tariffs and time schedules within sixty (60) days from the effective date of the certificate. Neither of these conditions has been complied with.

Applicant has advised the Commission in writing that he does not desire to accept the certificate and requests that it be revoked.

In view of the foregoing facts and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 35673 be, and it hereby is, revoked and annulled.
