abandon that portion of the route on
Taylor and Rosecrans Streets; and for
permission to reroute the La Mesa Bus
Line over Normal St. and abandon
that portion of the route on University
Avenue and Park Boulevard.

ORDER

San Diego Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to reroute its Linda Vista and Pacific Beach bus lines along the proposed routes shown in Exhibit "A", attached to the application and more particularly described as follows:

Pacific Beach Bus Line

Commencing at the intersection of First Avenue and Broadway; thence via Broadway, Second Avenue, C Street, Fourth Avenue, E Street, First Avenue, Broadway, Pacific Highway, Camino del Rio, Morena Boulevard, Balboa Street, Carnot Street and Fanuol Street to Tourmaline Street.

Linda Vista Bus Line

Commencing at the intersection of First Avenue and Broadway; thence via Broadway, Fourth Avenue, E Street, First Avenue, Broadway, Pacific Highway, Camino del Rio, Morena Boulevard, Greenwood Street, and Linda Vista Road to Sixth Avenue Extension.

San Diego Electric Railway Company is also authorized to reroute its La Mesa Bus Line along the proposed route shown in Exhibit "C", attached to the application and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of Fourth Avenue and C Street; thence via Fourth Avenue, E Street, Third Avenue, C Street, Fourth Avenue, University Avenue, Normal Street, El Cajon Avenue and La Mesa Boulevard in the City of La Mesa.

The above routings in so far as these lines are concerned, shall be in lieu of and not in addition to the lines now in effect.

This authorization shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Written acceptance of the certificate herein granted shall be filed within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof.
- (2) Said service shall commence within a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.
- (3) Prior to the inauguration of the new routings, the public shall be given at least five (5) days notice in advance by posting suitable signs on all motor coaches operated on these lines.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
